Topic-Measures**

Activity- Hands-on

Title: Counting Coins - Let's Go Shopping!

Objective:

- Students will be able to identify and count different combinations of coins.
- Students will practice making purchases and giving correct change in a simulated shopping activity.

Materials:

- Play money (coins and bills)
- Price tags for various items (use pictures or create simple labels)
- Whiteboard and markers
- Chart paper and markers
- Individual whiteboards and markers
- Worksheets with pictures of coin combinations
- Calculator (optional)

Activity:

Shopping Time: Allow students to move around the room, "shopping" for items. They need to calculate the total cost of their purchases and make sure they have enough money.

Title: Opposite Word Pairs

Objective:

- Students will be able to identify and understand opposite words.
- Students will use opposite words in sentences.

Materials:

- Flashcards with opposite word pairs (e.g., big/small, hot/cold, happy/sad)
- Whiteboard and markers
- Individual whiteboards or paper for students
- Worksheets with sentences and blanks for opposite words

ACTIVITY

- **Opposite Word Discussion:** Start by discussing the concept of opposites with the students. Ask them if they know what opposite words are and if they can provide any examples.
- **Opposite Word Pairs Flashcards:** Show flashcards with opposite word pairs. Discuss each pair, emphasizing the meaning of opposites. Encourage students to come up with their own examples.

Objective:

- Students will understand and identify the different stages of human life.
- Students will create a visual representation of the stages of human life.

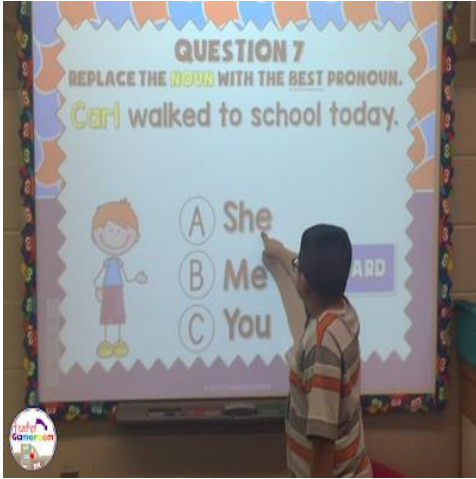

Activity- Plant growing experiment- students can make a report of their plant as it grows, noting the date of each stage of the process and documenting the changes in the pictures. This resource is a useful way to introduce students to the concept of scientific studies and experiments. It is not only a simple activity to prepare for a lesson, but it is also a fun project for students that will engage them with the topic.



- Large poster paper or cardboard
- Markers, crayons, and colored pencils
- Magazines or printed images representing different life stages (optional)
- Glue
- Labels with stage names (baby, child, teenager, adult, etc.)

Activity:

- **Group Work - Creating Life Stage Posters:**

- Divide the class into small groups (4-5 students per group).
- Provide each group with a large poster paper or cardboard, markers, crayons, and scissors.

- **Life Stage Collage:**

- Ask each group to draw or cut out pictures representing different life stages from magazines or printed images. They can include images of babies, children, teenagers, and adults.
- Encourage creativity in depicting the characteristics of each life stage.
