Maths

This game was conducted for numerals. Teacher made the group of six students and showed a slide with numerals between 1 to 10 to each group. After 1 min next slide was shown in which one number was missing. The child who told

that missing number first was the winner. This activity was done as a part of the student's mathematical concept development.

Place Value on Abacus Activity

As on a modern calculator, each column of **beads** represents a "place" value from which children build a numeral. So, the farthest column on the right would be the "ones" place, the second farthest the "tens"



Topic- Numbers to 100 Activity- Estimate and actual count



This activity was conducted to improve the estimation skills of the students. The teacher gave them some pieces of paper and they must paste it in an estimation circle. After counting, they will come to know about the actual number and estimated number. They easily determined the reasonable range of their answers.
